A printed program could have the SNHS emblem on the front, along with the school name and date. Inside the front cover was a list of members, and on the third page the program as below:

The parents/audience/guests are welcomed. Then the Colors are presented followed by the National Anthem. Guest Speaker is at discretion of Chapter.

After the Guest Speaker finishes, the sponsor will welcome everyone and introduce the officers. As they are sworn in, they will light an alcohol lamp prepared for the occasion. We placed the alcohol lamps on a table in front of a large emblem of the SNHS that one of our teachers made for us. Each alcohol lamp flame was a different color (red, yellow, green, blue, purple) and was very effective.
